Dear Families & Friends:

Given the recent COVID-19 surge throughout the state, OPWDD has issued new guidance on Interim Visitation for Certified Residential Facilities. This new guidance is dated January 4, 2022 and takes **effect immediately**.

- All visits to the homes must be scheduled ahead of time and approved by the provider agency (and visitation is not allowed in homes that are in mandatory quarantine or isolation). Visits shall be staggered so as not to have multiple families visiting in a shared space at one time and to ensure adequate time to clean any common areas or high touch surfaces between visits.
- 2) All visitors must remain masked regardless of vaccination status and visitors who refuse to wear a face mask must be asked to leave the facility;
- 3) All visitors should be 18 years of age or older, except in rare exceptions as determined by the facility;
- 4) Prior to each scheduled visit, visitors must undergo symptom and temperature checks by facility staff and shall be denied visitation if they report any COVID-19 exposure or symptoms during the prior 14 days, or have a temperature over 100.0 degrees Fahrenheit.
